

#### What is the workshop?

#### What is the workshop?

- A workshop for students who are together in the classroom, delivered by a trainer who is remote
- Two 2-hour sessions of interactive, group and individual exercises
- Includes a teacher resource pack and opportunities for teacher CPD in embedding oracy across the curriculum
- Participants share their views, learn from each other and at the end of the day will have spoken out on a topic of their choice

#### What do we require?

- Two 2-hour time slots (can be on the same day or different days, during school or after school)
- Access to Zoom/Microsoft Teams or a video calling platform of your choice
- A classroom with a projector/screen and audio so that the trainer can be seen and heard by all students
- 🏑 A mixed ability group of 12-20 students in Year 10
- A teacher in the room actively supporting the facilitation
- All work materials for students are posted to the school, they just need a pen


